

# Instructions



Follow the instructions to operate your watch. Please ensure you do not try to set the time in wet or humid conditions and you push the crown back into correct position once you have completed your adjustments.



### Position 1: Winding

This watch has a push down crown and will wind itself automatically when worn. If the watch has stopped running, it is recommended to wind the watch by turning the crown clockwise for approx. 40 turns (40 seconds) prior to wearing.



### Position 2a: Date adjustment

First set the time as instructed in (3) to ensure that the date will change between 11:00pm and 12:00am (Otherwise the date may change at midday).

Gently pull the crown out to position (2) then turn it anti-clockwise to set the date quickly.

Do not adjust the date if the time on the watch is set between 8pm and 2am as this can damage your watch movement.



## Position 2b: 24hr hand adjustment

Pull the crown to the same position as the date adjustment in position (2) and turn the hand clockwise to set the 24hr hand.

### Position 3: Time adjustment

Pulling the crown into the position (3) will stop the seconds hand so that time can be set by moving the crown clockwise to adjust the hands. You can also set the date in this position, by forwarding the time between approx. 11:00pm and 12:00am.

# Setting the second time-zone

The 24-hour hand allows you to read the time in an additional time zone.



### Set the local time

First set your local time by adjusting the hands of the watch as in (3) on the previous page.

For example, the local time is set to 10:10.



### Find the second time zone

Next, find the time zone in the location you want to set.

For example, if the local time is 10:10 and the second time zone is +6 hours then the time is 16:10 in the second time zone.




### Adjust the 24 hour hand

Pull the watch crown out to position (2) as detailed on the previous page and turn the crown clockwise until the 24-hour hand is pointing to the hour for the second time zone.

For example, if the local time is 10:10 and the second time zone is +6 then set the 24 hour hand to 16 on the dial.

Finally, remember to push the crown back into position (1).



### Watch care

Your watch has been engineered to be highly robust and with the correct care will last for many years.

Please ensure that you follow the tips below when caring for your watch.

### Cleaning

To clean your watch case and sapphire crystal use water with mild soap and a soft cloth.

#### Water resistance

Ensure the crown is pushed in all the way before any contact with water. Do not pull the crown out to adjust the time or date when the watch is submerged in water or if you are in a very humid environment.

#### Sea water

If your watch has been in sea water, then afterwards, wash the watch with fresh water.

#### Shock resistance

The watch and movement has been engineered to be robust, however try and avoid any heavy shocks to the watch. This includes any sports such as golf which can cause damage to the watch if worn whilst playing over a long time period.

### Magnetic fields

Avoid placing the watch near items which may contain magnetic fields (such as loudspeakers) as this may cause the watch to run incorrectly and require it to be demagnetized.

# Two year warranty

Your watch is warranted by Pinion Watch Company Ltd for a period of twenty four (24) months from the date of purchase.

The warranty covers material and manufacturing defects which may exist at the time of purchase, and during the warranty period, you have the right to have any defect repaired free of charge.

### The warranty does not cover:

- Normal wear and tear and aging (e.g. any colour change, or scratches made to any parts of the watch).
- Any damage from accidents, abnormal use or incorrect use of the watch. This includes damage to the movement.
- The watch being opened, altered or repaired by a non-authourised person.

# Technical specifications

#### Movement

Automatic Swiss made ETA 2893-2. 21 Jewels. Frequency: 28,800 vibrations per hour. 42 hour power reserve.

#### **Functions**

Time in hours, minutes, seconds. Date display. Quick date setting. Hacking seconds feature. Configurable 24-hour hand / second time zone (GMT).

#### Case

Titanium 42mm in diameter (excluding crown) strap lug width 22mm. Engraved screw down case-back with watch serial number engraving. Watch crown at 3H.

### Crystal

Sapphire crystal with anti-reflective coating (Inside).

### Dial

Painted dial with applied numerals / indexes filled with Swiss Superluminova® coating SLN C1-GL.

### Hands

Coated brass hands with Swiss Superluminova® coating (hour, minutes, seconds, 24-hour hand).

### Water resistance

10ATM (100 metres).

### Strap

Hand made 22mm leather strap with a stainless steel pin buckle.

# Servicing

It is recommended you service your Pinion watch every 3-5 years to ensure that essential maintenance can be carried out and that any worn parts such as gaskets (to retain water resistance) can be replaced.
